1. St. Rita School offers excellent training in the Catholic Faith. Positive: 94.45%
2. St. Rita School offers an excellent academic program. Positive: 91.38%
3. St. Rita School offers a comprehensive Physical Education and Athletic Program that benefits the children. Positive: 87.55%
4. St. Rita School offers a generous selection of extra-curriculars (such as fine arts, speech and debate, music, field trips, after school enrichment classes and before and after school Day Care.) Positive: 88:09%
5. St. Rita School presently offers nutritious lunch programs. Positive:43.53%
6. St. Rita School's Inclusion of secured sand and play equipment area convenient to early year student classrooms is essential. Positive:81.63%
